Sl. No.	Subject Area	Explanatory Remarks
1	Impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on the business	<p>The Company's manufacturing facilities remained largely shut from March 23, 2020 to May 3, 2020 as per the directive of the Government.</p> <p>During the lockdown period, the company extended support to the Government by producing personal protective equipment (PPE) for doctors, nurses, and other hospital support staff treating COVID-19 victims. With the permission of the Government, we opened a few of our factories with reduced workforce to produce such equipment to serve the national cause.</p> <p>The lockdown and closure of operations adversely impacted the business during April and May 2020. The company faced some cancellation, deferment of orders as well as delayed payments from customers.</p>
2	Ability to maintain operations including the factories/units/office spaces functioning and closed down. Schedule, if any, for restarting the operations	<p>After lockdown was eased on May 4, 2020, the company reopened all its factories.</p> <p>The company has always prioritized health, safety and well-being of its employees, their families, and other stakeholders. The company has put in place a robust protocol for ensuring workplace safety, and social distancing norms and shall continue to strengthen it further, based on the Government of India recommendations.</p>
3	Steps were taken to ensure smooth functioning of operations	<p>The Company has taken all necessary steps to adhere to the guidelines for social distancing and various directives issued by relevant Government authorities and has put in place safety measures keeping in mind the safety, health and well-being of the employees.</p> <p>All the facilities available across the company have been sanitized so that our employees are safe and secure. The safety protocols of temperature sensing, wearing of masks, face shields, social distancing, sanitizing, and washing hands are being adhered to very stringently.</p>

4	Estimation of the future impact of COVID-19 on its operations	<p>The company lost over 50% of its production capacity in the first quarter due to the lockdown being in effect. The company saw cancellation/deferment of orders by its customers as well. The company is now in the process of ramping of its production capacity to meet the delivery requirements of its customers.</p> <p>The company's performance is closely dependent on the recovery of its key customers in North America and Europe. An early recovery will minimise the impact in the near future.</p>
5	Details of the impact of CoVID-19 on listed entity's:	
5.1	Capital and Financial resources	The company's banking arrangement remains intact and is in a position to meet its short-term obligations. The company also has approached its bankers for additional emergency credit lines under RBI COVID-19 regulatory norm.
5.2	Profitability and liquidity position	<p>Q1 financial performance will be affected due to the outbreak of the pandemic and the consequent lockdown.</p> <p>There are no liquidity concerns in the company and we have sufficient cash flows from operations as well as banking limits to meet its obligations. With additional adhoc-facilities from the banks, the company's cash position is well-positioned to manage its operations.</p>
5.3	Ability to service debt and other financing arrangements	The Company has adequate unutilised working capital facilities to meet its financial requirements. With tight control over expenditure and available credit limits, the company will be able to serve its debt and other financing obligations. In line with the RBI circular, the company has applied for a moratorium on working capital payments.

Most of the customers' retail stores are still shut and are expected to open soon thereby reviving end user demand.
